Hartismere School Uniform Guidance

School jumper or cardigan (compulsory)

black, with school logo

Blazer (optional)

black, with school logo

Plain white shirt (compulsory)

- Plain white shirt with a collar
- Short or long sleeves
- Top button fastened
- Tucked into skirt or trousers

Tie (compulsory)

• The knot should be centered, sitting neatly just below the collar without any gaps

Plain black trousers

- Full length, covering the ankle
- Plain in cut and pattern
- Traditional school style
- No jeans, cargo, skinny fit, flares or leggings

Pendle Tartan Skirt (optional)

- Must be knee length or longer
- Waistband must not be rolled over

Socks & tights

- Black socks
- Neutral or black tights
- No patterned or white socks, or socks with sport 'flash' or logo



Other

- No necklaces or metal bracelets should be visible
- One small flat ring may be worn
- No 'smart' watches
- No facial or body piercing
- Nose studs may not be worn in school
- Small stud earrings only (maximum one in each ear)
- Discreet makeup is permitted for students in year 10 and above
- False eyelashes are not permitted
- Nail polish, acrylic or fake nails must not be worn
- Hair should be reasonable in style and natural in colour
- White, black, blue or yellow hair bands are permitted
- Pupils must have a plain school bag large enough to carry A4 books and equipment; small handbags are not acceptable

Shoes

- Black, sensible shoes that can be polished.
- No boots
- No trainer type shoes, flashes or logos



Coats

- Coats must not be worn in the school building
- Hoodies are not permitted

The school reserves the right to decide what is acceptable



PE & Games Kit Guidance

- Sky blue polo shirt with school logo (compulsory)
- Navy microfleece with school logo (compulsory)
- Navy/sky reversible rugby/games shirt (optional)
- Navy games shorts with school logo(compulsory)
- Navy skort with logo (optional)
- Navy cuffed track pants or navy sport leggings (optional)
- Football boots
- Trainers
- Navy turnover sports socks
- White socks

Other

- All pupils will need the polo shirt for all PE lessons from the start of the autumn term
- The microfleece may not be needed until the weather becomes cooler
- All pupils will need a water bottle with them for PE lessons
- A gum shield is required for hockey or rugby (available to purchase at pupil services)
- Pupils' own hockey sticks or tennis racquets may be brought in if they wish
